



Building Warden

Skill Development Certification Programme

TARGET AUDIENCE – This course is designed for Staff, teachers and Students who could be required to undertake Building, Floor and Area Warden Duties in their place of work.

AIM – To assist employees to overcome any reluctance to act in an emergency, recognise and take immediate action to initiate emergency evacuations and carry out initial attack fire suppression actions in the home and workplace until the NZ Fire Service arrives.

VENUE – This course can be conducted in your workplace where there are appropriate facilities provided and safety and environmental issues can be addressed.

CONTENT – This 1 day ‘Hands-On’ practical Lifesaving knowledge and skills programme covers *legislation, fire evacuation procedures*, roles and responsibilities of wardens, warden identification, Types of fire, Triangle of fire, types and operation of portable and fixed fire suppression equipment, fire fighting techniques.

PRACTICAL EVACUATION EXERCISE – Finally we tie all the theory into a practice by allowing students to run and take part in a number of practical evacuation exercises and experience extinguishing controlled (live) fires of different types and intensity using our live fire simulator. This provides participants with an opportunity to practice duties, test procedures and experience using extinguishers and hose reels utilised at their place of employment.

ASSESSMENT – An individual's competency will be assessed against FRSITO performance criteria using various assessment methods including answering questions whilst demonstrating practical fire fighting skills. Individuals become certified as competent to Rural Fire Fighter level by being assessed.

CERTIFICATION – Participants who are deemed competent will receive a **Fire Wardens** certificate and be credited with the above unit standards to validate that they have received structured **Building Warden** and **Fire Extinguisher** training in accordance with AS3745 and the procedures on safety and operation set down by the host employer pursuant to the requirements of the Fire Safety & Evacuation of Building Regulations, the Health & Safety in Employment Act and associated Regulations.
